AUCTION RULES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Each person attending the auction will be required to register as they enter the auction room. The **Registration Book will require your name, postal address, phone number and signature**. Each person will then be given a bidder number. As a successful purchaser of any lot you are required to show this bidder's number to the Auctioneer's clerk to prepare your receipt for payment. Your Bidder's number is to be returned at the completion of the sale.
2. The highest bidder shall be the purchaser and in the event of any dispute arising the Lot in dispute shall be put up again and the auctioneer's decision shall be final, please raise your bidder number in the air to attract the auctioneer's attention for each bid.
3. Payment for Lots purchased shall be cash, bank cheque also payment by **EFTPOS** will be available. Personal cheques cannot be accepted for payment of purchases on the day, unless arrangements have been made prior to the commencement of the auction. Until payment in full of the purchase money is made the property in the Lot shall not pass to the purchaser.
4. If you are unable to attend, phone bidding will need to be arranged prior to the day, with an additional costing for transport and travel box for any purchases made, all care will be taken but we accept no financial responsibility for mishaps while in our care or in transit after the auction
5. **The show cages are not included in the purchase price and are not for sale.**
6. All statements in this catalogue, or attached to auction show cages as to the origin, genuineness, provenance or condition of any Lots should not be relied upon as statement or fact. **Intending purchasers must satisfy themselves as to sex, colour, variety, age, genuineness and condition of Lots they may be interested in.**
7. Transport cages will not be permitted into the main Auction Hall until the conclusion of the Auction.
8. The Vendors may be paid out on the day of the sale or payment will be by cheque as soon as possible after the sale, but no later than 14 days thereafter. Payment to the Vendor will be less a commission, as agreed with Eastern District Budgerigar Society Inc. **Note: Any Vendor who purchases any Lots on the day can offset those purchases against sales made (less commission).**
9. **BUYERS PLEASE NOTE** that all birds purchased at Auctions in 2018 will have a **2% BCV Levy** added to the final purchase price.
10. At the end of the Auction buyers shall proceed to payment table where they shall pay **purchase price plus the 2% BCV Levy** and will receive a receipt. This receipt will be required for collection of birds.
11. Eastern District Budgerigar Society Inc. act as an Agent only in respect of the goods to be auctioned and is not responsible for any faults or defects in any of the Lots auctioned on the day.
12. Freight can be arranged for any birds purchased by interstate buyers, who will need to allow for transport and travel box cost

BREEDERS PROFILES

NORM WHEATLEY. WA:

I have been breeding budgerigars for 48 years, I first started showing in 1991 and was lucky enough to have one Clearwing and a Recessive Pied selected in the State team. Always restricted by distance travelling 600kms from Kalgoorlie to Perth, this meant that I would only show once a year at the State selection. Gaining my first National placing of 2nd in 1993 with a Recessive Pied, in 1995- I ran 1st and 6th with Recessive Pieds, in 2010- 2nd D/F Spangle, 2012- 3rd Blue Class, 2013- 1st in Recessive Pied also 1st & 3rd D/F Spangle, 2014- 4th Opaline AOSV, 4th Spangle AOSV and 3rd Recessive Pied, 2015- 4th Dilutes and 5th, 6th & 8th Spangles, 2016- 2nd Grey Greens. Have now gained 3 wins, 3 seconds, 3 thirds and 4ths at National level in different classes.

I now reside in Geraldton which still means that to travel to a show is a 10 hour round trip down and back, this means I only show at 2 shows per year, that being the State and National selections.
